SUBJECT: Completion of Capitol Display Redesign

### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Receive a presentation from Board of Supervisors' staff regarding the completion of the redesign of the Tulare County Capitol Display.
- 2. Approve the dissolution of the Tulare County Capitol Display Ad Hoc Committee.

#### SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Capitol Display is a glass-enclosed display case located outside of the Governor of California's conference room. It is a high traffic area that sees many visitors come through every day. The display was last updated in December of 2014 by the Leadership Porterville class. Unfortunately, It has had technical malfunctions that triggered a review of the display altogether.

On August 18, 2017, the Board of Supervisors appointed two members to sit on an Ad Hoc Committee to assist County staff with evaluating the redesign of the Capitol Display. Supervisor Kuyler Crocker and Supervisor Amy Shuklian worked with staff and members of the Arts Consortium to provide direction on the initial components of the display. The DMI Agency later joined the project to help execute the committee's vision and facilitate the remainder of the process.

On September 18, 2018 staff presented a new design of the display to the Board of Supervisors. DMI Agency rendered a design that includes the rich agricultural commodities that grow within the county. It highlights major tourism attractions including the General Sherman Tree and the Giant Sequoias as well as provides a

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history of major events that helped shape Tulare County. The Board provided direction and approved the design presented.

On March 13, 2019, Board staff along with DMI Agency staff traveled to Sacramento to install the Capitol Display. Staff is bringing the Board an update on the process, showcasing the final installment and asking the Board to dissolve the committee upon the completion of the project.

#### FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The Fiscal Year 2018/2019 Board of Supervisors Budget includes a one-time allocation of \$15,000 to accommodate the refurbishment of the Capitol Display for Tulare County. Staff anticipated spending the funds on redesign, transportation, and placement at the Capitol.

#### **LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

The Tulare County Capitol Display Redesign is linked to the Quality of Life initiative – Promote public health and welfare, educational opportunities, natural resource management and continued improvement of environmental quality.
