SUBJECT: Adopt a resolution proclaiming "Healthy Tulare County Week"

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Adopt a resolution proclaiming the week of April 1 through April 7, 2019, Healthy Tulare County Week.

SUMMARY:

Healthy Tulare County Week is celebrated and recognized each year to coincide with National Public Health Week. Since 1995, when the first full week of April was declared National Public Health Week (NPHW), communities across the United States have observed NPHW as a time to recognize the contribution of public health and highlight issues that are important to improving our nation and country. This year's theme is "Creating the Healthiest Nation: For science. For action. For health".

During Healthy Tulare County Week, the Public Health Branch, along with its community partners, will reach out to county residents to educate, inform, and encourage healthy activities. Everyone deserves to live a long and healthy life in a safe environment. To make that possible, we need to address the causes of poor health and disease risk among individuals within our communities. The community we live, learn, work, worship, and play in affects each of us and can determine our health and life expectancy. Healthy Tulare County Week seeks to increase the awareness of the determinants of health by engaging in activities that recognize and support better health for all.

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FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The budgeted costs associated with these activities were included in the HHS 6005 budget, line 7066, special department expense, not to exceed \$500. There is no additional cost to the County General Fund

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Quality of Life initiative to promote public health and welfare, education opportunities, natural resources management and continued improvement of environmental quality, as well as an organizational performance initiative to improve organizational effectiveness and fiscal stability. Healthy Tulare County Week supports the Quality of Life initiative by providing highlighting the opportunities for health agencies and health allies to educate the public, policymaker, and practitioners on programs and services that support better health outcomes and highlight health issues that are important in building healthier communities.
