



- Feb. 2017 Re-ranked as #5 FC Priority Project
- Mar. 2017 Project enters Design Phase
- Jun. 2018 Meeting with Friant Water Authority
- Jul. 2018 Conceptual design completed, 60% plans submitted to stakeholders
- Feb. 2019 90% Plans completed
- Apr. 2019 Encroachment permit to USBR
- Summer 2019 Bidding/Construction Begins*
