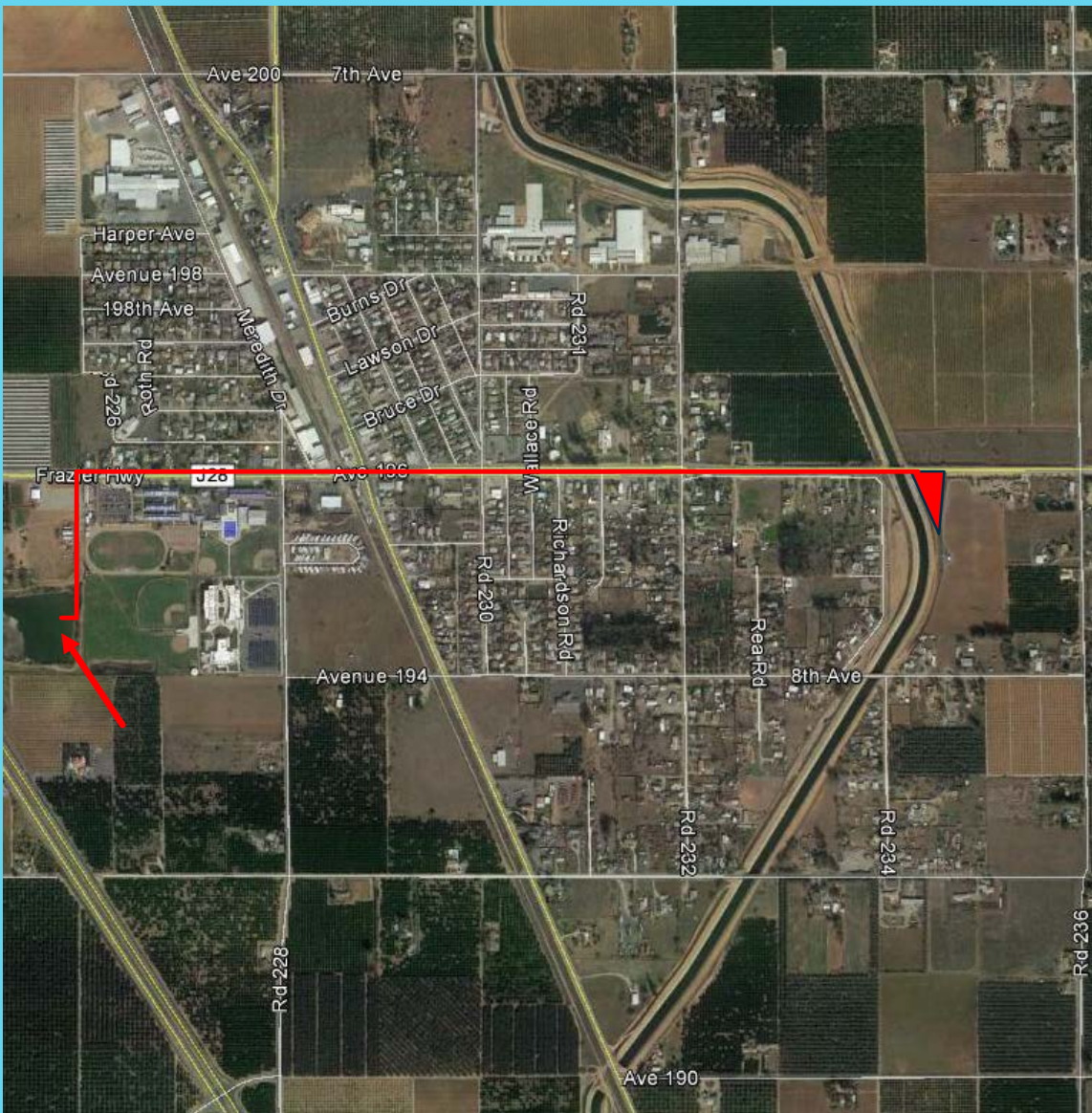

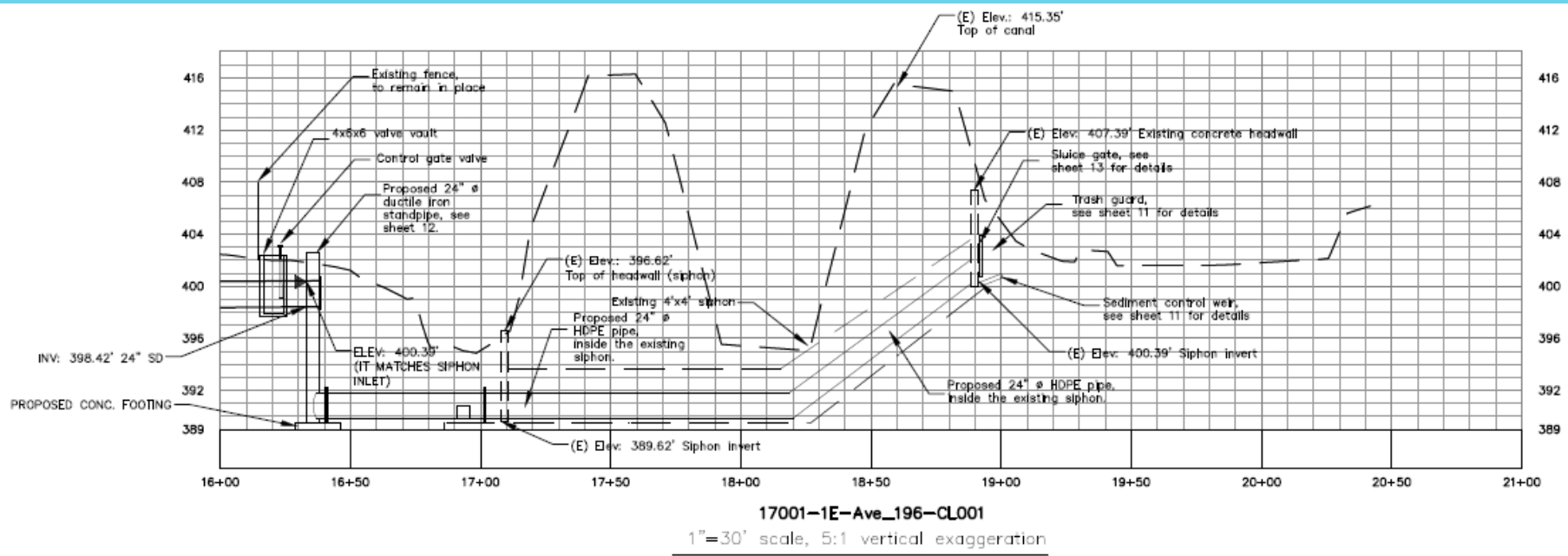

PROJECT DESIGN



Estimate: \$600,000

PROJECT SCHEDULE & BACKGROUND

- Feb. 2017 – Re-ranked as #5 FC Priority Project
- Mar. 2017 – Project enters Design Phase
- Jun. 2018 – Meeting with Friant Water Authority
- Jul. 2018 – Conceptual design completed, 60% plans submitted to stakeholders
- Feb. 2019 – 90% Plans completed
- Apr. 2019 – Encroachment permit to USBR
- Summer 2019 – Bidding/Construction Begins*
