SUBJECT: Designation of Jeremy Meyst Memorial

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Approve the designation of a section of Road 132 in memory of Tulare County Sheriff Correctional Deputy Jeremy W. Meyst.

SUMMARY:

Tulare County Sheriff's Correctional Deputy Jeremy Meyst was tragically killed in a crash on December 24, 2013 while transporting inmates. Deputy Meyst had served with the Tulare County Sheriff's Office for nine years. He is survived by his wife and two sons.

This year marks the fifth anniversary of Deputy Meyst's untimely death. In commemoration of his service, the Meyst family submitted a request, received in October 2018, for the County to designate the portion Road 132, between the Visalia city limits to Ave 328, in Memory of Deputy Meyst.

The request has been reviewed and approved by a Honorary Road Naming Committee, in accordance with Tulare County Administrative Number 12. The committee was composed of the personnel from the following offices: Resource Management Agency, County Administrative Office, County Counsel, Board of Supervisors, General Services Agency, and Office of the Tulare County Sheriff. Upon Board approval, a sign will be placed on the shoulder of the Road 132 on both ends of the honorary section.

The memorial sign will read:

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is No Net County Cost to the General Fund. Costs to install the memorial signage are minimal and are included in the current year's Road Fund budget for miscellaneous signage.
