SUBJECT: Agreement with Carpi & Clay, Inc.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an agreement with Carpi & Clay, Inc. for federal advocacy services, in the amount of \$91,200 annually, plus qualified reimbursable costs, for the term July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2021, with two optional one-year extensions for the same services and payment; and
- 2. Authorize the Chairman to sign four copies of the agreement.

SUMMARY:

Carpi & Clay provides services related to Federal legislative matters including preparation and representation of the County on Federal priority issues; preparation of briefing materials and the arrangement of appointments with legislators and agencies; regular communication with the County's legislative staff and written reports to the Board; and presentations to the Board of Supervisors and County staff, among other services.

The proposed agreement includes an increase of \$4,680 annually over the current agreement pricing, is a two year agreement, and allows for two one-year extensions at the same pricing.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The costs associated with the agreement will be included in the FY20 budget.
