Overview of existing Ordinance for Stopping, Standing and Parking

Specifically:

Chapter 3 of Part III of the Ordinance

- Section 3-03-1015 of Article 1 Prohibits commercial vehicle parking over 5 tons
- Article 5 Sets parking restriction for limited periods

Article 7 - Angled Parking

Existing Procedure for Ordinance Update

To date, these Articles list the location restrictions within the Ordinance. To add or remove a restriction, the following procedures are currently implemented:

- For Article 1 Parking Restrictions only, schedule a public hearing and publish notice of the hearing in a newspaper at least 10 days prior to the date of the public hearing at the Board Meeting.
- 2. Hold a public hearing at a Board meeting to introduce the ordinance. Set a date for the second reading at least two weeks later.
- 3. Publish a summary of the ordinance before the second reading.
- 4. At the second reading, adopt the Ordinance.
- Publish the Ordinance.
- 6. Wait 30 days from date of adoption for the ordinance to take effect.

Amended Procedure

To simplify the process to efficiently respond to constituent and enforcement requests for parking restriction, staff is proposing the following parking restriction procedure outlined as follows:

- 1. Request your Board approve the proposed parking restrictions
- 2. Upon receipt of the Board's resolution approving the parking restriction, the Director of Transportation will then erect signs and/or mark the curbs to indicate the parking restrictions.
- 3. All parking restrictions will be compiled and listed on the master list of parking restrictions, held at the Resource Management Agency. (RMA)

After execution of the adopted resolution, staff will bring to your Board at a later date additions and deletions for your consideration for approval.

Staff Request

Staff is requesting your Board to consider the following:

- Hold a public hearing regarding the proposed Ordinance amendment.
- Introduce and waive the first reading of the proposed Ordinance to amend Chapter 3 of Part III of the Tulare County Ordinance Code, regarding Standing, Stopping, and Parking
- 3. Set the second reading for May 21, 2019
- 4. Close the public hearing and direct the Clerk to publish a summary of the ordinance as required by state law.
