SUBJECT: Approve an agreement with Kings View Corporation

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an agreement with Kings View Corporation for the Porterville Wellness and Recovery Center, in the amount not to exceed \$533,000, effective from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020; and
2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign two (2) copies of the agreement.

SUMMARY:

The Porterville Wellness and Recovery Center (PWRC) is a community-based multi-service center that provides services to Transitional Age Youth (ages 18-24), adults (ages 25-59), and older adults (ages 60+) with severe mental illness and/or severe emotional disturbance. The Porterville Wellness and Recovery Center provides a supportive environment offering choices and self-directed guidance for advancing/cultivating wellness and recovery through services such as peer support groups, educational guidance, vocational services, fitness, independent living skill development, and socialization. Under this agreement, the center will provide services to at least 50 unduplicated consumers each month for the duration of the contract.

On March 2, 2016 the Tulare County Health & Human Services Agency (HHSA), Mental Health Branch, released a Request for Proposal for the operation of the Porterville Wellness and Recovery Center. After reviewing the proposals, it was recommended that the contract be awarded to Kings View Corporation and approved by the Tulare County Mental Health Board on June 1, 2016. Kings View Corporation has successfully operated the Porterville Wellness Center since opening its doors on

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
FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The budgeted costs associated with this contract were included in the HHS 3331 budget, line 7043 professional services, in the amount not to exceed \$533,000 and is included in Fiscal Year 2019/2020 budget submission. This agreement is funded with Mental Health Service Act, Community Services and Supports revenue. There is no net cost to the County General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year plan includes the Quality of Life initiative to promote and encourage the provision of quality supportive services for individuals of Tulare County. The Porterville Wellness and Recovery Center will benefit residents of Tulare County by working to promote wellness, recovery, and resilience in the mental health community, and reducing the negative outcomes often associated with severe and persistent mental illness.
