SUBJECT: Approve an amendment to Agreement No. 28554 with Parenting Network, Inc.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an amendment to Agreement No. 28554 with Parenting Network, Inc. Family Resource Center in Visalia to decrease the maximum amount of the agreement from \$281,000 to \$279,582 for the provision of a Differential Response Pre and Post Services program effective May 21, 2019 through June 30, 2019; and
2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign two (2) copies of the amendment.

SUMMARY:

Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA), Child Welfare Services, entered into a contract with Parenting Network, Incorporated Family Resource Center (PN FRC) in Visalia to provide Differential Response (DR) Pre and Post Services as part of the Promoting Safe and Stable Families Program (PSSF), funded by the Department of Social Services.

The purpose of this amendment is to update Exhibits A & B to decrease the maximum amount of Agreement No. 28554 from \$281,000 to \$279,582. The proposed decrease is due to a Department of Social Services County Fiscal Letter (#18/19-34), issued on December 14, 2018, which informed HHSA of a funding decrease of \$7,090 to the allocation for the PSSF Program. PN FRC in Visalia is one of five vendors recommended by the Joint Allocation Committee and the Tulare

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County Child Protection Planning Council to receive a decrease of funds. The decrease was split among the five vendors to arrive at the amount of \$1,418 each.


FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

This agreement is funded through the Child Abuse Prevention and Intervention Treatment; Child Welfare Services; and Promoting Safe and Stable Families Program funds which are flexible State and Federal allocations for an array of services for families with children. County Fiscal Letter 18/19-34 was issued on December 14, 2018 informing HHSA of a funding decrease to the PSSF allocation by \$7,090. Due to the decrease, we are amending the contract to reflect the decrease in funding specific to the PSSF program, line 6043-7043 professional services from \$281,000 to \$279,582. The budgeted costs associated with this contract were included in the HHSA 001-142 budget, line 6043-7043 professional services. These funds are included in the adopted Fiscal Year 2018/2019 budget submission. There is no additional net cost to the County General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Quality of Life Initiative that encourages innovative provision of quality supportive services for at-risk youth and children in state and federally mandated programs. Differential Response case managers provide community resources to families to keep from entering Child Welfare Services. This agreement increases the ability to fulfill that obligation. This agreement increases the ability to fulfill that obligation by supporting families from entering Child Welfare Services with services provided by the Family Resource Center.
