Authorize the submission of a grant application with the U.S.

Department of Justice

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize the submission of an online grant application for funding from the U.S. Department of Justice, Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program, for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020 to assist in the purchase of vests for the Sheriff's Office and Probation Department.

SUMMARY:

The U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP) grant program, allows law enforcement agencies to recoup up to 50 percent of the cost for the purchase of bullet resistant vests issued to its staff. In FY 18/19, BVP awarded a total of \$29,876,699 over 4470 jurisdictions nationwide. The Probation Department and Sheriff's Office have a need to purchase bullet resistant vests during Fiscal Year 19/20. If awarded, Tulare County's award amount will offset a portion of the expenditures of the bulletproof vests with the grant revenue.

The BVP is an online only application and will be completed and submitted by the Sheriff's Office on behalf of both County agencies. Per BVP policy, only one agency is authorized to apply for the BVP on behalf of a County. The Sheriff's Office requests that your Board give approval to submit the online grant application for the BVP grant by the application submission due date of May 28, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The BVP reimburses the County for a portion of bulletproof vest expenditures up to

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50 percent, including tax and shipping charges. If awarded, Tulare County's award amount will offset a portion of the expenditures of the bulletproof vests with the grant revenue, and funds will be included in each respective department's FY 19/20 requested budgets. There will be no additional net County cost to the General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic business plan includes the Organizational Performance initiative to continuously improve organizational effectiveness and fiscal stability. The BVP fulfills this initiative by reimbursing the County for expenditures.


