**SUBJECT:** Approve an agreement with Kings View Corporation

**REQUEST(S):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an agreement with Kings View Corporation for the provision of South County Mobile Services, effective July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020 in the amount not to exceed \$850,000; and
2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign two (2) copies of the agreement.

**SUMMARY:**

The Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency, Mental Health Branch, collaborates with Kings View Corporation to provide mental health services through the South County Mobile Services program under the Mental Health Services Act Community Services and Supports component. The South County Mobile Services program provides an integrated mental health service experience for all age groups with severe and persistent mental illness or serious emotional disturbance with emphasis on serving those traditionally unserved and underserved in the rural communities of South Tulare County. The South County Mobile Services strategy is intended to decrease barriers in accessing mental health services seen in rural communities. From July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020, the program plans to provide services to 150 unduplicated consumers in addition to participating in community outreach and engagement opportunities.

Tulare County Mental Health Branch released a Request for Proposal (RFP) in May 2013 for the South County Mobile Unit. Through the proposal process, Kings View Corporation was the only organization to submit an application. The RFP Review

Team recommended they be awarded the contract. Kings View has been providing quality services to the rural communities of Tulare County since being awarded the initial contract in 2006.

As part of the agreement, the County will be providing a previously purchased wheelchair accessible van to be used by Kings View Corporation to reach consumers in remote areas of the County through outreach activities, community events, and for consumer transport to appointments, activities, and groups that will assist consumers in their wellness and recovery plan.

This contract does not deviate from the standard County boilerplate.


**FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

The budgeted costs associated with this contract will be included in the HHS 3331 budget, line 7052 medical providers, in the amount not to exceed \$850,000 and is included in the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 budget submission. These services are paid through State Medi-Cal reimbursement and Mental Health Services Act revenues. There is no additional net cost to the County General Fund.

**LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

The County's five-year plan includes the Quality of Life initiative to promote and encourage the provision of quality supportive services for individuals in Tulare County. Tulare County children and youth will benefit from the provision of mental health services by the South County Mobile Services.
