Approve an agreement with Kings View Corporation

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an agreement with Kings View Corporation for the South County One-Stop Center program for mental health services, effective July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020 in the amount not to exceed \$700,000; and
- 2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign two (2) copies of the agreement.

SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency, Mental Health Branch, collaborates with Kings View Corporation to provide mental health services through the South County One-Stop Center under the Mental Health Services Act Community Services and Supports component. The South County One-Stop Center is designed to offer a wide array of integrated services to youth ages 12 to 15, and transitional age youth ages 16 to 25. The South County One-Stop Center employs a Children's System of Care model that promotes the integration of mental health services and quality of life approaches such as employment, education, drug/alcohol counseling, and life skills training.

Tulare County Mental Health Branch released a Request for Proposal (RFP) in 2013 for the South County One Stop. Through the proposal process, only one proposal was received. After review of the proposal, the RFP Review Team

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recommended Kings View Corporation be awarded the contract. Kings View Corporation has a long history of providing quality mental health services in Tulare County and has been providing these services continually since being awarded the initial contract in 2006.

This contract does not deviate from the standard County boilerplate.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The budgeted costs associated with this contract were included in the HHSA 3331 budget, line 7052 medical providers, in the amount not to exceed \$700,000 and is included in Fiscal Year 2019-2020 budget. This agreement is paid through State Medi-Cal reimbursement and MHSA revenues. There is no additional net cost to the County General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year plan includes the Quality of Life initiative to promote and encourage the provision of quality supportive services for individuals in Tulare County. Tulare County children and youth will benefit from the provision of mental health services by the South County One-Stop Center.
