Approve a Memorandum of Understanding with Transitions

Children's Services

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- Approve a Memorandum of Understanding with Transitions Children's Services to provide services on behalf of Tulare County Child Welfare Service's foster children. This will include the care and placement of foster children through cooperation, collaboration, and sharing of appropriate information, effective June 4, 2019 through June 30, 2022; and
- 2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign two (2) copies each of the Memorandum of Understanding.

SUMMARY:

Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency, Child Welfare Services Division has mandates from statutory codes that require placement of a child in a safe and caring foster home when a child is removed from his or her home due to abuse, neglect, and/or exploitation. Welfare and Institutions Code Section 16500 states, "The Legislation hereby declares its intent in providing for this statewide system of child welfare services that all children are entitled to be safe and free from abuse and neglect." As part of this legislation, Child Welfare Services monitors each foster family agency when any Tulare County foster child is placed in any of the County's foster homes for compliance with the delivery of services and placement regulations. Child Welfare Services meets quarterly with participating foster family agencies to ensure children are receiving quality services. New Era Group Home will ensure that the physical, emotional, and academic needs of children in their care

are met, agree to participate fully in the child and family's case plan as established by the County and work to facilitate positive outcomes for children and families including the transportation for all case plan services as well as all medical, mental health, family visits, academic, and social events. Transitions Children's Services will ensure that the physical, emotional, and academic needs of children in their care are met, agree to participate fully in the child and family's case plan as established by the County, and work to facilitate positive outcomes for children and families including the transportation for all case plan services as well as all medical, mental health, family visits, academic, and social events. The goal of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to provide a collaborative approach for the delivery of safe, secure, and compassionate homes that meet placement regulations and court ordered case plan services for foster children in Tulare County when removed from their home.

The MOU does not require a competitive Request for Proposal, as any foster family agency may request to enter into a MOU.

The following term deviates substantively from standard County boilerplate: This MOU has a term commencing upon Board approval and signature through June 30, 2022.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is no cost associated with this MOU, therefore, there is no additional net cost to the County General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Quality of Life Initiative that will support monitoring of a foster family agency foster home for Tulare County foster children. The MOU will encourage and support an innovative provision of quality supportive services for at-risk youth and children placed in the foster family agency foster homes. The quality of life for these at-risk youth and children will be improved with the support of the MOU to be safe and free from abuse and neglect while placed in the foster family agency foster homes.
