**SUBJECT:** Approve an Agreement Amendment with the PAAR Center.

**REQUEST(S):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an Amendment to Agreement No. 28809 with the PAAR Center to increase the value of the Agreement by \$250,000, for a total amount not to exceed \$600,000, to provide offenders recently realigned under state legislature with residential treatment, training services, and outpatient services, retroactive from January 1, 2019 through June 30, 2019. This Amendment is retroactive due to an unanticipated spike in the need for treatment services.
2. Find that the Board had the authority to enter into the proposed Amendment as of January 1, 2019, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the Amendment on that date.
3. Authorize the Chairman to sign three (3) copies of the Agreement.

**SUMMARY:**

The PAAR Center is a non-profit, community-based facility that provides residential and out-patient substance abuse treatment for adult felony offenders. Referrals include individuals subject to Post-Release Community Supervision, in addition to individuals placed on Mandatory Supervision or Formal Probation pursuant to Sections 1170(h) and 1203 of the Penal Code. The PAAR Center is committed to providing treatment and case management services in an effort to break the course of addiction, improve the quality of lives, and reduce recidivism.

**SUBJECT:** Approve an Agreement Amendment with the PAAR Center.  
**DATE:** June 18, 2019

In an effort to address the provisions of AB 109, and the influx of 1) Low-Level State Prison Post-Release (PRCS); 2) Low-Level Non-Violent, Non-Serious, and Non-Registerable Sex Offenders; 3) Existing violators of Parole who will not be returned to State Prison; and 4) Any offenders who are placed on Felony Probation, the Probation Department needs to enter into contracts and linkages with community-based services for placement, treatment, counseling, employment, education, and training of such individuals.

The Probation Department has an established relationship with the PAAR Center, who have received referrals and provided treatment interventions to adult offenders since October 10, 2011.

Due to an unanticipated spike in the need for treatment services, an amendment is needed to pay the invoices for the remainder of FY 2018-2019, as the vendor has been providing services since January 2019, without receiving payment.

The proposed Amendment to Agreement No. 28809 does not include any terms that substantively deviate from the standard County boilerplate.


**FISCAL IMPACT / FINANCING:**

The anticipated cost for services during Fiscal Year 2018/2019 was \$350,000, which was included in the FY 2018/2019 budget. The additional anticipated cost of \$250,000, to an amount not to exceed \$600,000 will be absorbed in the FY 2018-2019 department operating budget. The costs associated with the agreement are offset by revenue received from SB 678 and AB 109. There are no additional net County costs to the General Fund.

**LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

The County's five-year strategic business plan includes the Safety and Security initiative that provides for the safety and security of the public. The approval of this Amendment to Agreement No. 28809 helps fulfill this initiative by contracting with PAAR for community-based treatment services designed to improve the quality of lives and reduce recidivism.
