SECOND AMENDMENT TO TULARE COUNTY AGREEMENT NO. 28273

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT ("Amendment") to Tulare County Agreement Number 28273 (the "Agreement") is entered into by and between the COUNTY OF TULARE ("COUNTY") and Government Payment Service, Inc. (d/b/a "GovPayNet", a Delaware corporation, having a principal place of business at 7102 Lakeview Parkway West Drive, Indianapolis, Indiana 46248, referred to as GPS, ("CONTRACTOR") as of _______, with reference to the following:

- A. The COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into the Agreement on July 1, 2017, to obtain the services of accept credit and/or debit card payments made by consumers on behalf of the COUNTY for the purpose of collecting restitution from probationers.
- B. COUNTY and CONTRACTOR have previously entered into an amendment to the Agreement on July 1, 2018 to extend the term one additional year and;
- C. COUNTY and CONTRACTOR now wish to amend the Agreement in order to extend the term for one additional year.

- B. This Second Amendment becomes effective as of July 1, 2019.
- D. Except as provided above, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
