SUBJECT: Approve an Agreement with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an Agreement with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to provide law enforcement services at Success Lake Recreation Areas in an amount not to exceed \$75,436.08, retroactive to the performance period of May 15, 2019 through May 14, 2020. The Agreement is retroactive due to a delay in receiving the agreement for processing from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed Agreement as of May 15, 2019 and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date.
3. Authorize the Chairman to sign three copies of the Agreement.

SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Sheriff's Office (TCSO) has provided law enforcement patrol services to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) at Success Lake Recreation Areas for many years. Under this agreement, one Deputy Sheriff and patrol vehicle will be assigned to service the Success Lake Recreation sites located within Tulare County. Law enforcement service days shall be on all applicable Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays, and Federal holidays falling within the performance period.

SUBJECT: Approve an Agreement with the United States Army Corps of Engineers
DATE: June 18, 2019

The primary duties of the Deputy Sheriff will include answering calls for service, routine patrol, response to emergency calls, and investigation of criminal offenses occurring in the USACE recreation, administration, and wildlife management areas.

The Success Lake Recreation Areas to be serviced under this agreement include:

- Park Headquarters (HQ)
- Dam and Lower Compound Outlet Works Area
- North and South Tule Campgrounds
- Tule Day Use Area
- Tule Point Recreation Area
- Rocky Hill Recreation Area
- Visa Point Recreation Area
- Wildlife Management Recreation Area
- Gill Cove Recreation Area
- Big Sycamore Trail and Old Rustlers Recreation Areas

The reimbursement amount covered by the Agreement is \$75,436.08 and is effective for the performance period of May 15, 2019 through May 14, 2020.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

Total revenue to be billed to the USACE will not exceed \$75,436.08. Funds are included in the Sheriff's FY 18/19 and 19/20 operating budget. There is no net County cost to the General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Safety and Security Initiative. This agreement will help fulfill this initiative by allowing the Sheriff's Office to provide enforcement of criminal laws of the State of California and the County of Tulare, on lands administered by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
