Approve an agreement with Kings View Corporation

AGENDA ITEM

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- Approve an agreement with Kings View Corporation for the provision of opioid treatment services, in the amount not to exceed of \$1,445,000, retroactive from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. This agreement is retroactive due to delays in receiving vendor signatures. It was impracticable for the Board to take action prior to July 1, 2019 due to the time needed to process, prepare, and submit the agenda item;
- 2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed agreement as of July 1, 2019, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date; and
- 3. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign two (2) copies of the agreement.

SUMMARY:

Kings View Corporation provides Drug/Medi-Cal (DMC) Opioid Treatment Program (OTP)/ Narcotic Treatment Program (NTP) services to DMC eligible consumers. Consumers enrolled in this program also receive physician follow-up services and referrals to/from other agencies for rehabilitation. DMC eligible consumers from anywhere in Tulare County may be treated at this facility. The target population is opioid dependent individuals age eighteen (18) and older. In addition, Kings View Corporation provides methadone detox for eligible consumers funded through 2011 Realignment Funds. It is estimated that two hundred (200) unduplicated consumers will be served through this agreement.

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This program is operated under the California State Department of Health Care Services Substance Use Disorder program regulations, as outlined in Title 9 of the Administrative Code.

This agreement did not include a Request for Proposal process because review for Kings View Corporation is one of three contractors that provide OTP/NTP services to Tulare County consumers and the County has agreements with all three.

There are no deviations from the standard County boilerplate.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The budgeted costs associated with this contract were included in the fiscal year 2019/20 requested budget for HHSA specifically in unit 6068 budget for medical providers, the amount of \$1,445,000. The funding is derived from Drug Medi-Cal and 2011 Realignment. There is no additional net cost to the County General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Quality of Life Initiative that encourages innovative provision of quality supportive services for at-risk adults, youth and children in state and federally mandated programs. This agreement increases the ability to fulfill that obligation through residential, outpatient, intensive outpatient, and transitional programs.
