SUBJECT: Approve an Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture regarding Phytophthora ramorum inspections for Fiscal Year 19/20.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture, to provide State funding of \$8,270.95 to offset costs of providing high risk terminal inspection services for the state Phytophthora ramorum Inspection program from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. This agreement is retroactive because the document was not received until July 25, 2019.
2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed Agreement as of July 1, 2019, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the Agreement on that date.
3. Authorize the Chairman to sign two copies of the Agreement.

SUMMARY:

The Phytophthora ramorum inspection program is responsible for enforcement of California state interior quarantines regarding Sudden Oak Death (SOD). Inspectors conduct agricultural inspections at residences, landscaping stock yards, and nurseries. The Phytophthora ramorum program helps protect Tulare county agriculture from the introduction of SOD.

SUBJECT: Approve an Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture regarding Phytophthora ramorum inspections for Fiscal Year 19/20.

DATE: September 10, 2019

This agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel. The following terms deviate substantively from the standard County boilerplate:

- 1) Neither party to the agreement will indemnify the other.


FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

No additional net county cost to the General Fund. The County will receive funding up to \$8,270.95 for Fiscal Year 2019/2020 from the California Department of Food and Agriculture. Revenues and the associated expenditures for this program will be included in the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer's Fiscal Year 2019/2020 budget.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Economic Well-Being Initiative to promote economic development opportunities, effective growth management, and a quality standard of living. This request to authorize an Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture is for the purpose of performing Phytophthora ramorum inspections which serve to protect the County's agriculture-based economy by ensuring all Phytophthora ramorum infested nursery stock is kept out of the marketplace.
