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SUBJECT:

Approve an agreement with California Department of Social

Services

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- Approve an agreement with the California Department of Social Services to ensure the security and privacy of Personally Identifiable Information retroactive from September 1, 2019 through September 1, 2022. This agreement is retroactive due to changes to the Exhibits received from the State; making it impracticable for the Board to take action prior to September 1, 2019;
- 2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the agreement as of September 1, 2019 and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date; and
- 3. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign seven (7) copies of the agreement.

SUMMARY:

The California Department of Social Services (CDSS) is entering into revised agreements with each County Welfare Department to ensure the security and privacy of Personally Identifiable Information (PII). The Federal Social Security Administration (SSA) requires that CDSS enter into these agreements to safeguard client PII & SSA information that may be viewed during the eligibility determination process for the various social services program. This agreement covers County of Tulare, Department of Health and Human Services Agency, which may access, use,

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or disclose PII during the administration of the CalFresh, California Food Assistance Program, California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids, Cash Assistance Program for Immigrants, Entrant Cash Assistance, Refugee Cash Assistance, Foster Care, Kinship Guardianship Assistance, Federal Guardianship Assistance Program, General Assistance, General Relief, and the Trafficking and Crime Victims Assistance Programs. This agreement replaces Tulare County Agreement No. 28073 entered into on May 16, 2017. Approximately, twenty-six percent of the residents in Tulare County receive some form of services through one or more of these programs.

The following terms deviate substantively from the standard County boilerplate: 1) County signs first; 2) The State may terminate immediately for cause; and 3) The State may terminate the agreement with a 30-day notice if the County fails to promptly enter into negotiations to amend the agreement when requested by the State or does not enter into an amendment the State deems necessary.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is no cost associated with this agreement; therefore, there is no additional net cost to the County General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Organization Performance initiative that provides state-of-the-art technology and infrastructure to support better service delivery. This agreement increases the ability to fulfill this obligation by maintaining confidentiality and security protocols for the protection of client privacy during administration of Tulare County social services programs.
