### SUBJECT:

Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture regarding Pink Bollworm Cotton Plowdown.

### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for providing State subvention in the amount not to exceed \$2,667.00 to offset the costs of providing the Pink Bollworm Cotton Plowdown and Host-Free Monitoring program, from November 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020. This Agreement is retroactive because the document was not received from the State until October 3, 2019.
- Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed Agreement as of November 1, 2019, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the Agreement on that date.
- 3. Authorize the Chairman to sign two copies of the Agreement.

### SUMMARY:

This agreement is intended to render State financial aid to the County for providing enforcement of Pink Bollworm Cotton Plowdown and Host-Free Monitoring program. This is a continuing program that works to minimize the number of pests that can adversely impact the cotton industry in Tulare county.

This agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel. The following terms deviate substantively from the standard County boilerplate:

SUBJECT: Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture

regarding Pink Bollworm Cotton Plowdown.

DATE: December 17, 2019

1) Mutual Liability, parties agree to be liable for their own wrongful or negligent action, neither party indemnifies the other.

2) Attorney's Fees, in the case of breach of contract, recipient agrees to pay all costs incurred by CDFA including, but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees, legal expenses, and costs.

### FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

No additional net County cost to the General Fund. The County will receive funding up to \$2,667.00 for Fiscal Year 2019/2020 from the California Department of Food and Agriculture. Revenues and the associated expenditures for this program are included in the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer's Fiscal Year 2019/2020 adopted budget.

## LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Economic Well-Being Initiative to promote economic development opportunities, effective growth management, and a quality standard of living. The request to approve this Agreement will provide a continued funding source that will allow the continuation of a program that protects the County's agricultural economy.
