SUBJECT: Approve an agreement with Success in Recovery, Inc.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an agreement with Success in Recovery, Inc., a Short-term Residential Treatment Program in an amount not to exceed \$1,050,000 retroactive from September 1, 2019 through June 30, 2021, for the provision of intensive mental health services to Tulare County adolescent males. This agreement is retroactive due to a delay in negotiation of terms, making it impracticable for the Board to take action prior to September 1, 2019;
2. Find that the Board had authority to approve this agreement as of September 1, 2019 and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date; and
3. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign two (2) copies of the agreement.

SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency (HHS), Mental Health Branch, is establishing an agreement with Success in Recovery, Inc., a Short-Term Residential Treatment Program (STRTP), to provide specialty mental health services to Tulare County adolescent males. Success in Recovery, Inc. will provide specialty mental health treatment modalities including the following services: mental health assessments, individual and group therapeutic counseling, medication support, case management, and crisis intervention.

Success in Recovery, Inc., STRTP offers the highest level of care possible for

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Tulare County adolescent males who are full-scope Medi-Cal beneficiaries or have been authorized by the Tulare County Resources Intensive Services Committee for admission and provides an alternative and less restrictive environment than Juvenile Hall, County Camps, or California Youth Authority. Additionally, all male adolescents must be dependents of Tulare County Child Welfare Services Division or a ward of Tulare County Probation Department, and unable to be maintained in a lower level of care in California. Through this agreement with Success in Recovery, Inc., it is estimated that approximately 24 consumers will be served for Fiscal Year 2019-2021 (12 consumers per Fiscal Year).

This agreement did not include a Request for Proposal (RFP) process because Success in Recovery, Inc. is classified as a STRTP that offers mandated mental health services for high needs adolescent males in Tulare County's Child Welfare Services Division and Probation Department. Tulare County has access to a very limited number of STRTP's to serve this population.


FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The budgeted costs associated with this agreement were included in the HHS 1221 budget, line 7052 medical providers, in the amount not to exceed \$1,050,000; \$450,000 is included in the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 budget and \$600,000 will be allocated for Fiscal Year 2020-2021. The average estimated cost per consumer is \$50,000 per Fiscal Year. The estimated amount is subject to change based on actual utilization. These services are paid through State Medi-Cal billing reimbursement and local mental health realignment revenues. There is no additional net County cost to the General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Quality of Life Initiative that encourages innovative provision of quality supportive services for at-risk adults, youth and children in state and federally mandated programs. This agreement increases the ability to fulfill that obligation by providing intensive mental health services to Tulare County children and adolescents.
