SUBJECT: Public Hearing to Consider Franchised Hauler Special Circumstances Rate Adjustment for the unincorporated area of Tulare County.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Conduct a Public Hearing considering an increase to the Franchised Hauler's maximum collection and ancillary rates for Service Areas A, B, C, D, E, G, H, and J in accordance with Section 11.3: Special Circumstances Rate Adjustment set forth in Tulare County Franchise Agreements Number 27185-A, 27186-A, 27187-A, 27188-A, 27189-A, and 27190-A.
2. Approve the recommended maximum collection and ancillary rates per attached Exhibit "A", effective January 7, 2020.

SUMMARY:

On June 16, 2015, the Board of Supervisors approved Franchise Agreements with Miramonte Sanitation Inc., servicing Area A (27188); Pena's Disposal Inc., servicing Area B (27185); USA Waste of California Inc servicing Area C and H (27189); Mid Valley Disposal LLC, servicing Areas D & E (27190); Tule Trash Company servicing Area G (27187); South Tulare Richgrove Refuse Inc., servicing Area J (27186). The goals of the Franchise Agreements are to integrate and align the collection system with the County's solid waste and recycling activities.

The Board of Supervisors may consider adjustments to the maximum rates that the Franchise Haulers can charge their customers pursuant to the Franchise Agreement. The Franchise Agreements also stipulate that the Franchised Hauler (Hauler) is entitled to apply for a Special Circumstances Rate Adjustment of all

maximum rates upon application based on Section 11.3.

Monumental changes to the recycling markets have lead to increased cost to the collection and processing sector leaving the entire industry for recyclable material reeling. Local outlets face additional challenges with high contamination levels in the recyclable material collected and proximity to ports. As a result, recyclers nationwide have resorted to stockpiling vast quantities of recyclables, in hopes the market may improve. Many are now reaching their storage capacity, and have resorted to landfilling some recyclables as a limited and temporary measure where necessary in order to preserve public health.

The Solid Waste Department received the request for relief based on Special Circumstances from the Franchise Haulers and began working on processing and collection costs with a third party consultant and local processors. The major factors driving those costs are the declining market for recyclable material and the dearth of viable outlets nationally.

Based on those factors the Department requested individual recycling tip cost from each of the Haulers, generated an average and factored it against total Hauler gross receipts to determine that a three (3) percent adjustment would be appropriate at this time.

The proposed rates have been noticed pursuant to Government Code section 66018 (see Exhibit B) and published pursuant to Government Code section 6062a and 6066, in the Sun Gazette Exeter, a newspaper of general circulation, on December 25, 2019, and January 1, 2020. Pursuant to Tulare County Ordinance Code 4-03-1255, the Franchised Haulers informed the effected customers in each respective jurisdiction of the intent to increase the fees; approximately 24,500 notifications were sent out. (see Exhibit C).

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is no net County cost associated with this action. There is no net impact to the Enterprise Fund as a result of the rate increase, as these are approved maximum rates charged directly by the Franchised Haulers to the customer.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Economic Well Being Initiative to promote and provide a business-friendly, can do service ethic. This adjustment to the maximum collection and ancillary rates will help fulfill this initiative by providing a mechanism to the Franchise Haulers to account for increases in costs associated with performing collection activities.
