<u>SUBJECT</u>: Letter of Support for a Surface Water Treatment Project in Northern Tulare County

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve a letter of support for a surface water treatment project in northern Tulare County.

SUMMARY:

Tulare County has been an advocate for a surface water treatment plant in the north County for a number of years. The County was the recipient of a Local Entity Formation Assistance grant, which provided funding to form the Northern Tulare County Water Alliance (Alliance). The Alliance represents five communities in the north County, including East Orosi, Sultana, Monson, Yettem, and Seville. In April 2019, the Alliance submitted a funding application to the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) for planning funds to move forward on the design and engineering of a surface water treatment plant. The surface water treatment plant would provide drinking water to its five member communities, as well as the potential to serve other communities in the region. The SWRCB denied the Alliance's request in September 2019 and recommended the Alliance pursue regional solutions, which do not include new infrastructure projects. The Alliance continues to meet and is pursuing regional shared solutions.

After leaving the Alliance Joint Powers Agreement negotiations, the Cutler and Orosi Public Utilities Districts formed their own Joint Powers Authority to pursue the same surface water treatment project.
