Background

- Trap Neuter and Return (TNR) Pilot Program with the Visalia Feral Cat Coalition (VFCC) began May 2016
- Purpose to humanely and effectively stabilize and gradually reduce Mooney Grove Park's feral cat population
- After four years the program accomplishments include:
 - Total population has remained stable at under 20 cats
 - All cats are tested for feline immunodeficiency virus and feline leukemia when they are trapped. After being cleared they are vaccinated for rabies, FVRCP and FeLV.
 - In 2019 trapped and tamed 16 kittens and one mom cat. They were to send to rescues to find loving homes.
- In 2019, throughout the community, the VFCC spay/neutered over 1700 cats and placed 200 kittens up for adoption





Proposed Agreement

- Staff and the VFCC have been working together to modify the initial agreement to ensure the goals are mutually beneficial.
- Proposed Term: three years with an option to renew an additional year, up to two years. If approved today, the Agreement could potentially be active for a total of five years.
- Proposed New Program Goal: Attempt to relocate feral cats away from the visitors and County facilities to ensure program does not disturb normal park activities or pose a threat to park patrons, employees, or County property.
