SUBJECT: Tulare County Maintained Mileage of 2019

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Adopt that the maintained mileage was 2,972.82 miles as of December 31, 2019.
2. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to return to the Resource Management Agency a certified copy of the resolution to be filed with the State of California Department of Transportation.

SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Resource Management Agency is responsible for the maintenance of county roads in the Tulare County Maintained Mileage System. An annual report is required to be submitted to the State of California, in accordance with Streets and Highways Code Section 2121, which states the maintained mileage as of the end of the calendar year (2019) and which states the additions and exclusions to the maintained mileage with respect to the prior year (2018). The maintained mileage as of December 31, 2019 is 2,972.82, which is the same as for 2018. There were no additions or exclusions to the maintained mileage in calendar year 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:


Tulare County receives a portion of funding for roadway maintenance from the State for its maintained mileage, which is apportioned based on a variety of factors including the number of registered vehicles in the County and the amount of mileage that the County maintains. Modifications to the maintained mileage in these relatively small amounts will have minimal net fiscal impact to Tulare County.
