SUBJECT:

Approve a Capital Asset Purchase

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve a capital asset purchase of an Onan Quiet Diesel Generator for the Mobile Fire Command Bus, in an amount not to exceed \$15,000; and
- 2. Approve the necessary budget adjustments per the attached AUD 308 (4/5th vote required).

SUMMARY:

County Fire is in the process of repurposing a mobile health clinic that was generously donated to the department by HHSA. The self-contained mobile unit will be utilized as a Mobile Fire Command Bus on complex and extended incidents throughout Tulare County. The Bus requires various upgrades and repairs and replacement of the unit's generator as it is more than ten years old. The cost to replace the generator is \$14,696.40; nonetheless it is essential as it will serve as the primary power source in remote locations for several hours. Funds to replace the generator were budgeted in the department's FY 2019/20 budget; however, the cost of the generator exceeds the Capital Asset threshold of \$5,000, and requires Board approval.

As mentioned, the Mobile Fire Command Bus will be used on complex and extended incidents. These incidents generally span large geographical areas, have multiple operational periods, and require extensive planning and logistical support. The Bus will allow personnel the ability to collaborate, plan, and establish a remote incident command post in the most difficult areas of Tulare County. At present, the

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Mobile Fire Command Bus will assist the department with managing the growing number of incidents from COVID-19, improving operational ability by providing an isolated environment where personnel can function out of the elements. The Bus will also decrease potential risk of exposure to personnel when managing large scale incidents involving hundreds of personnel and citizens.

The fire department is requesting authorization to obtain a purchase order to replace the existing generator on the Fire Command Bus. Once refurbished, the Bus will become a key resource in the planning, operational and logistical support for all types of major incidents that Tulare County Fire Department may face today and in the future.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is no additional cost to Tulare County to replace the generator as funds were budgeted in the department's FY 2019/20 budget. The cost of the generator shall not exceed \$15,000; the quote is for \$14,696.40 with a small contingency of \$303.60 for minor unforeseen costs. Staff is including an AUD308 merely to adjust appropriations from operational expenses to capital assets within its FY 2019/20 budget.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year Strategic Business Plan includes Safety and Security initiatives to provide for the safety and security of the public through coordinated emergency preparedness, response, recovery, and mitigation capabilities for both natural and man-made disasters.
