Three Rivers Museum Restroom Project

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve Amendment to Agreement No. 29317 with Sierra Range Construction to increase the agreement amount by \$9,750.97 from \$481,910.99 to \$491,661.96 for the Three Rivers Museum Restroom Project.
- 2. Authorize the Chair to sign the Agreement Amendment.

SUMMARY:

On August 13, 2019, the Board awarded the Three Rivers Museum Restroom Project to Sierra Range Construction in the amount of \$481,910.99. The project is located adjacent to the Three Rivers Historical Museum and will be accessible from Sierra Drive/HWY 198. The new structure consists of a men's, women's, and unisex bathrooms, fixtures, and path of travel to two new ADA parking spaces.

The project consists of site improvements and new construction including the building, plumbing, septic system, electrical systems and a new Southern California Edison (SCE) service connection. The contract documents allow for 120 calendar days of construction.

After the bid opening, there was a change in the project plans to the SCE service connection location. The original plans identified a pole for the service connection which did not have the required transformer. Instead, SCE recommended installing the service connection on a pole with the transformer that was farther away from the restroom. Although this does result in an increased cost, it proved to be more cost effective than installing a new transformer.

SUBJECT: Three Rivers Museum Restroom Project

DATE: April 28, 2020

The project is currently in the final stages of construction. It is anticipated there will be no other request for changes to the contract amount. The change order amount for extending the electrical infrastructure the additional distance is \$9,750.97. It is requested the board approve the amendment increasing the contract amount by \$9,750.97 from \$481,910.99 to \$491,661.96.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The project is funded by the Capital Projects Fund 030-086-3260-8146.
