SUBJECT: Approve an amendment to Agreement No 29146 with David E. Kilgore, M.D.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an amendment to Agreement No. 29146 with David E. Kilgore, M.D., for the provision of psychiatric services in an amount not to exceed \$454,000 (\$227,000 for each Fiscal Year 2019-2020 and 2020-2021), to include Exhibit A-1, Tulare County Mental Health Plan, Quality Management Standards; and to modify Exhibit B, Compensation for Fiscal Years 2019-2020 and 2020-2021, retroactive from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2021. This amendment is retroactive, as Exhibit A-1 was inadvertently not included and key language was omitted from Exhibit B when the Board approved the original agreement.
2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed amendment as of July 1, 2019, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the amendment on that date.
3. Authorize the Chair of the Board to sign one (1) copy of the amendment.

SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA), Mental Health Branch contracts with David E. Kilgore, M.D. to provide mandated psychiatric services to consumers who are part of the Mental Health Plan. Dr. Kilgore has provided competent psychiatric services as required by Tulare County since 2012. Due to the scarcity of specialty psychiatric providers, it is essential that the County

continue to use contracted psychiatrists to deliver services consistent with the level of care provided by professionals licensed in the State of California. This agreement provides telepsychiatry services to the Tulare County Mental Health outpatient clinics. Through this agreement with David E. Kilgore M.D., it is estimated that approximately 600 consumers will be served by this provider for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 through Fiscal Year 2020-2021.

The County of Tulare and David E. Kilgore, M.D. entered into Agreement 29146 on May 21, 2019 and are now requesting to amend the agreement to include Exhibit A-1, Tulare County Mental Health Plan, Quality Management Standards and revise Exhibit B, Compensation for Fiscal Years 2019-2020 and 2020-2021. Exhibit A-1 clarifies the County's expectations with regard to quality management standards. Exhibit B has been modified to include an hourly contracted rate of \$125 per hour for evaluation and medication services provided by Dr. Kilgore, not to exceed the total amounts payable under the Agreement.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The budgeted costs associated with this agreement were included in the HHSA 3323 budget, line 7052 medical providers, in the amount not to exceed \$454,000. The allocation for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 will be \$227,000; and \$227,000 for Fiscal Year 2020-2021. These services are paid through State Medi-Cal billing revenues. This provides a maximum of 1,816 hours provided by locum tenens for the County clinics. There is no additional net cost to the County General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Quality of Life Initiative to promote health and wellbeing for the citizens of Tulare County by attracting and retaining a broad range of health and mental health service providers. This amendment will help fulfill this initiative by providing quality psychiatric services to our consumers.
