**SUBJECT:** Approve an Amendment to Agreement No. 29455 with Central Valley Recovery Services.

### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

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- 1. Approve an Amendment to Agreement No. 29455 with Central Valley Recovery Services to increase the value of the Agreement by \$350,000, for a total amount not to exceed \$700,000, to provide offenders recently realigned under Assembly Bill 109 with residential treatment, training services, and outpatient services, and to extend the term through June 30, 2021; and
- 2. Authorize the Chairman to sign one (1) copy of the Amendment.

#### SUMMARY:

The Probation Department enters into contracts and linkages with community-based services for placement, treatment, counseling, employment, education, and training in an effort to address the provisions of Assembly Bill (AB) 109, and the influx of 1) Low-Level State Prison Post-Release (PRCS); 2) Low-Level Non-Violent, Non-Serious, and Non-Registerable Sex Offenders; 3) Existing violators of Parole who will not be returned to State Prison; and 4) Any offenders who are placed on Felony Probation.

#### SUBJECT: Approve an Amendment to Agreement No. 29455 with Central Valley **Recovery Services.**

Central Valley Recovery Services (CVRS) is a non-profit, community-based facility that provides residential and out-patient substance abuse treatment for adult felony Referrals include individuals subject to Post-Release Community offenders. Supervision, in addition to individuals placed on Mandatory Supervision or Formal Probation pursuant to Sections 1170(h) and 1203 of the Penal Code. Through this Agreement, services will be provided to an estimated 200 adult clients. The estimated cost per client is about \$1,750. CVRS is committed to providing treatment and case management services in an effort to break the course of addiction, improve the quality of lives, and reduce recidivism.

The Probation Department has an established relationship with Central Valley Recovery Services, which has received referrals and provided treatment interventions to adult offenders since October 10, 2011.

The term of the original Agreement was July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. The maximum amount payable under the original Agreement was \$350,000.

The original Agreement was approved as to form by County Counsel on October 9, 2019 and was approved by the Board of Supervisors on October 22, 2019. The original Agreement did not substantively deviate from the standard County Boilerplate. The proposed Amendment does not substantively deviate from the standard County Boilerplate.

The only changes to the original Agreement are a change in the time period of the Agreement and a change in the total dollar amount of the Agreement. The Amendment will extend the contract period an additional 12 months to June 30, 2021, and will increase the maximum amount of the Agreement from \$350,000 to an amount not to exceed \$700,000. The price for services has not changed.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT / FINANCING:**

The Amendment to Agreement No. 29455 with Central Valley Recovery Services includes extending the Agreement period from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2021, which will cost an additional \$350,000, and amending the total cost to an amount not to exceed \$700,000. The additional contract expense will be included in the Probation Department's FY 2020/2021 operational budget. The costs associated with the agreement are offset by revenue received from SB 678 and AB 109. There are no net County costs to the General Fund.

#### LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic business plan includes the Safety and Security initiative that provides for the safety and security of the public.
