FIRST AMENDMENT TO TULARE COUNTY AGREEMENT NO. 29455

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT ("Amendment") to Tulare County Agreement Number 29455 (the "Agreement") is entered into by and between the COUNTY OF TULARE ("COUNTY") and Central Valley Recovery Services, Inc. ("CONTRACTOR") as of July 1, 2020, with reference to the following:

- A. The COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into the Agreement on July 1, 2019, for the purpose of providing substance abuse treatment, residential treatment, transitional living, and intensive outpatient services;
- B. COUNTY and CONTRACTOR now wish to amend Agreement No. 29455 in order to increase the value of the Agreement by \$350,000, for a total amount not to exceed \$700,000, and to extend the term of the agreement to June 30, 2021.

ACCORDINGLY, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR agree as follows:

1. Effective **July 1, 2020**, paragraph 1 of the original Agreement entitled "TERM" is replaced with the following language:

TERM: This Agreement becomes effective as of July 1, 2019 and expires at 11:59 PM on June 30, 2021, unless earlier terminated as provided below, or unless the Parties extend the term by a written amendment to this Agreement.

- 2. The maximum amount of Agreement No. 29455 is increased by \$350,000 for a total amount not to exceed \$700,000.
- 3. Except as provided above, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
