- 1.1 By entering into this Program Supplement, SPONSOR agrees that it will only proceed with work authorized for specific phase(s) of the Project with written "Authorization to Proceed" or other AUTHORITY approval and will not proceed with future phase(s) of this Project(s) prior to receiving a written "Authorization to Proceed" or other AUTHORITY approval.
- 1.2 The SPONSOR will advertise, award, and administer the Project(s) in accordance with SPONSOR standards.
- 1.3 Contract award information shall be submitted by the SPONSOR to the AUTHORITY within 60 days after the Project contract award.
- 1.4 Failure to submit contract award information in accordance with section 1.3 will cause a delay (without interest or penalties) in AUTHORITY processing invoices for the construction phase of the Project.
- 1.5 If no costs have been invoiced for a six month period SPONSOR agrees to submit for each phase a written explanation of the absence of Projects(s) activity along with target billing date and target billing amount.

## Project Name: D112 over Bates Slough Bridge Project

### **Project Scope**

The scope of work for this Project includes the preliminary engineering phase, right-of-way phase, and construction phase, of the D112 over Bates Slough Bridge Project. Through this Program Supplement, Tulare County will rescind the previously executed agreement (Agreement No. 27813) and initiate all phases of the Project in accordance with Caltrans Local Assistance Procedures Manual (LAPM) guidelines.

### **Project Schedule**

The Project was initiated in early 2017. In November of 2017, Tulare County awarded a preliminary engineering contract to a design consultant to begin Project design. The Project was cleared through NEPA in early 2020 and final design is anticipated to be complete by summer 2021. Construction is anticipated to start in fall 2021 and will take approximately 6-9 months to complete.
