Memorandum of Understanding Between PROTEUS, INC. And TULARE COUNTY HEALTH & HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY – COMMUNITY FOOD OPERATIONS

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets forth general conditions of an agreement between **Proteus, Inc.** and Tulare County acting through the **Tulare County Health & Human Services Agency – Community Food Operations, hereinafter County**. The terms and conditions of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) shall be in effect from **April 16, 2020 until August 31, 2020.** Either party may terminate this agreement upon 30 days written notice. Any modification to this agreement must be made in writing.

The purpose of this agreement is to provide a non-financial MOU. There will be no funding involved between the two community partners for the delivery of basic emergency relief to residents living in Tulare County during COVID-19 crisis.

County agrees to hold harmless, defend and indemnify **Proteus**, **Inc.**, its Board of Directors, corporate officers, employees, volunteers, agents, and contractors against any and all claims, actions, costs, losses, damages or liability of any kind, including, but not limited to death or injury to any person or damage to any property arising out of the duties of those herein described pursuant to this Agreement, including any negligent acts on their part.

This agreement also specifically includes any claims that may be made against **Proteus**, **Inc.** by any taxing authority asserting that an employee-employer relationship exists by reason of this Agreement, or any claim made against **Proteus**, **Inc.** alleging civil rights violations under Government Code 12920 (California Fair Employment and Housing Act). This indemnification obligation shall continue in full force and effect beyond the term of this Agreement or any extension or other modification of the terms of this Agreement unless otherwise specified.

COUNTY's duty to indemnify, defend and hold harmless Proteus Inc., and its officers, agents and employees does not apply to acts or omissions taken by Proteus Inc., in relation to any failures or delays in paying wages, salary, or related benefits to its employees, or for the willful misconduct of employees, including Staff Members, delivering supplies for **COUNTY** under this Agreement. If it is finally adjudicated that liability was caused by the comparative negligence or willful misconduct of an Indemnified Party, then **COUNTY** may submit a claim to the Proteus Inc., for reimbursement of reasonable attorneys' fees and defense costs in proportion to the established comparative liability of the Indemnified Party. The following MOU outlines the duties and responsibilities of each party in this collaboration. Through this agreement, responsibilities of each party are as follows:

Proteus, Inc. Shall:

- a. Provide funding for the delivery project through existing funding with Southern California Gas Company, Community Services and Development and others.
- b. Provide two (2) Energy Trucks for essential delivery of goods including food.
- c. Provide two (2) Energy Staff members to deliver essential goods including food.
- d. Will cover all costs of deliveries (including driver salary, mileage, Workers' Comp.)
- e. Staff will be available for deliveries:

Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

- f. Maintain delivery routes within Tulare County.
- g. Energy Staff will drop off essential goods on porches, driveways or designated locations with no physical contact with any person (s) in the community and will maintain social distancing state guidelines at all times.

Tulare County Health & Human Services Agency Shall:

- a. Coordinate delivery pick up times and locations. And communicate this information to **Proteus Lead, Jose Gonzales, or his designee**.
- b. Maintain good communication and set up appointments with community partners including Food Link for food distribution and pick up availability.
- c. Reach out to community partners to find out about any additional delivery needs.
- d. Participate in regularly scheduled planning meetings with Proteus staff as needed.
- e. Keep accurate records that will track the number of individuals and locations being provided with delivery services.
