Approve an amendment to Agreement No. 29510 with Kansas

Health Institute

#### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an amendment to Agreement No. 29510 with Kansas Health Institute to initiate Cross-Jurisdictional Sharing Convening between Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency and the Tule River Tribe and to extend the term end date retroactive from June 19, 2020 to December 31, 2020. It was impracticable for the Board to take action prior to June 19, 2020 due to the time needed to process, prepare, and submit the agenda item.
- 2. Find that the Board had the authority to approve the amendment as of June 19, 2020 and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the amendment on that date.
- 3. Authorize the Chair of the Board to sign one (1) copy of the amendment.

#### **SUMMARY:**

On December 17, 2019, the board ratified and authorized the submission of a grant application to the Center for Sharing Public Health Services and approved a grant agreement from the Kansas Health Institute to accept one-time funding in the amount of \$10,000 to initiate Cross-Jurisdictional Sharing Convening between Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency and the Tule River Tribe.

The focus of the Cross-Jurisdictional Sharing Convening is on identifying the needs of the Tule River Tribe and on creating a plan that allows for the coordination of

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various social and health services to support the Tule River Tribal Members. The Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency has taken the lead on this effort which allows for the alignment of services and provides a mechanism by which to address the Tribe's needs and connect its members to supportive services.

The agreement as retroactively approved on December 17, 2019 specified a term of September, 20, 2019 through June 19, 2020. This amendment extends the termination date to December 31, 2020 and modifies the Project Milestones and Deliverables to reflect this change.

#### FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

This agreement generates revenue for Tulare County. The revenues for this agreement were approved for Fiscal Year 2019/2020 and will also be budgeted for Fiscal Year 2020/2021. There is no net cost to the County General Fund.

### LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

This agreement increases Tulare County's ability to support the County's five-year strategic plan and specifically the Quality of Life Initiative that promotes public health and welfare, educational opportunities, natural resources management and continued improvement of environmental quality. This project benefits the members of the Tule River Tribe by connecting them to services related to healthcare, mental health, addiction services and overall health related educational needs.
