SUBJECT:

Approve an Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for area wide Glassy-winged Sharpshooter control

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an Agreement No. 19-0727-011-SF with the California Department of Food and Agriculture in the amount of \$1,160,000 to provide area wide Glassy-winged Sharpshooter control, retroactive from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2022. The Agreement is retroactive because the document was not received from CDFA until June 23, 2020.
- 2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed Agreement as of July 1, 2020, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the Agreement on that date.
- 3. Authorize the Chairman to sign two copies of the Agreement.
- 4. Approve a Categorical Exemption consistent with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Title 14 California Code of Regulations (CCR), Section 15061(b)(3) Common Sense Exemption and Section 15308 Actions by Regulatory Agencies for Protection of Environment.
- 5. Find there is no substantial evidence that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment and determine a Categorical Exemption is consistent with the CEQA Title 14 CCR, Section 15061(b)(3) Common Sense Exemption and Section 15308 Actions by Regulatory Agencies for Protection of the Environment, that was prepared for area-wide Glassy-winged

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Sharpshooter control reflects the independent judgement of the County and has been completed in compliance with the CEQA of 19970, as amended.

6. Direct and authorize the Environmental Assessment Officer, or designee, to sign and file the Notice of Exemption with the Tulare County Clerk-Recorder.

SUMMARY:

This Agreement is intended to subvent costs incurred by the County when providing continuation of an area wide pest management program to mitigate the presence of the Glassy-winged Sharpshooter (GWSS) and substantially reduce populations in order to decrease the potential for the spread of Pierce's Disease. This two-year Agreement will continue Tulare County's efforts to detect and suppress the insect pest through FY 21/22 reimbursing growers who participate in this program for preapproved treatment costs.

This agreement deviates from County Contract Protocol in the following ways: 1) Both parties are required to indemnify one another, 2) In the case of litigation, the prevailing party is entitled to attorney's fees.

This agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel.

In accordance with CEQA, the County has also determined that a categorical exemption is applicable to the proposed action: State CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) Common Sense Exemption and Section 15308 Actions by Regulatory Agencies for Protection of the Environment.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

This Agreement provides for \$580,000 for FY 2020/21 and \$580,000 for FY 2021/22. The revenues and associated expenditures for this agreement have been or will be included in the Agricultural Commissioner's FY 2020/21 and FY 2021/22 budgets. There will be no additional net county costs in performing this program.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Strategic Initiative NO.2: Economic Well-Being. Approval of this Agreement will provide economic development opportunities, effective growth management and a quality standard of living. The program will provide continuation of an area wide pest management program to control this potentially devastating GWSS insect pest and is consistent with the County's objective of continuing to protect the County's agricultural-based economy.
