SUBJECT: No Parking Restrictions on Road 72, South of Riggan Avenue in the Community of Goshen

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the designation of a "No Parking" restriction on Road 72 just south of Riggan Avenue (A312) in the community of Goshen; and
2. Authorize the installation of "No Parking" signs, and establish a "No Parking" zone in Goshen, on the east side of Road 72 south of Riggan Avenue, by painting red approximately 140 feet of curb south and 100 feet north of the Goshen Village II Apartment complex entrance.
3. Approve a Categorical Exemption consistent with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Title 14 California Code of Regulations (CCR), Section 15061(b)(3) Common Sense Exemption;
4. Find there is no substantial evidence that proposed activity will have a significant effect on the environment and determine the Categorical Exemption is consistent with the CEQA Title 14 CCR, Section 15061(b)(3) Common Sense Exemption, that was prepared for the project reflects the independent judgment of the County and completed in compliance with the CEQA of 1970; and
5. Direct the Environmental Assessment Officer of the Tulare County Resource Management Agency, or designee, to file a Notice of Exemption with the Tulare County Clerk.

SUMMARY:

Road 72, south of Riggan Avenue (A312) is located in the community of Goshen, within

SUBJECT: No Parking Restrictions on Road 72, South of Riggin Avenue in the Community of Goshen

DATE: August 4, 2020

Tulare County. Road 72 runs in a north, south direction.

In response to safety concerns of parked vehicles creating a visibility obstruction for traffic entering Road 72 from the Goshen Village II Apartment complex, Tulare County Resource Management Agency (RMA) conducted an investigation. As a result, it was determined that “No Parking” restrictions installed 100 feet north and 140 feet south of the Goshen Village II Apartment complex entrance on Road 72 will provide improved sight visibility for traffic entering onto Road 72. Therefore, staff recommends the installation of “No Parking” signs and establish a “No Parking” zone by painting the curb red north and south of the apartment complex entrance.

Once this request is approved, this location will be added to the master list for parking restrictions maintained by RMA.

The Environmental Assessment Officer of the Tulare County RMA has found there is no substantial evidence that the activity/project will have a significant effect on the environment and determined a Categorical Exemption is consistent with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Title 14 CCR Section 15061(b)(3), the Common Sense Exemption is appropriate. A Notice of Exemption was prepared in compliance with the California State Guidelines for Implementation of CEQA. The Environmental Assessment Officer, or designee, will file the Notice of Exemption with the Tulare County Clerk upon approval by the Board.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:


No Net County Cost to the General Fund.

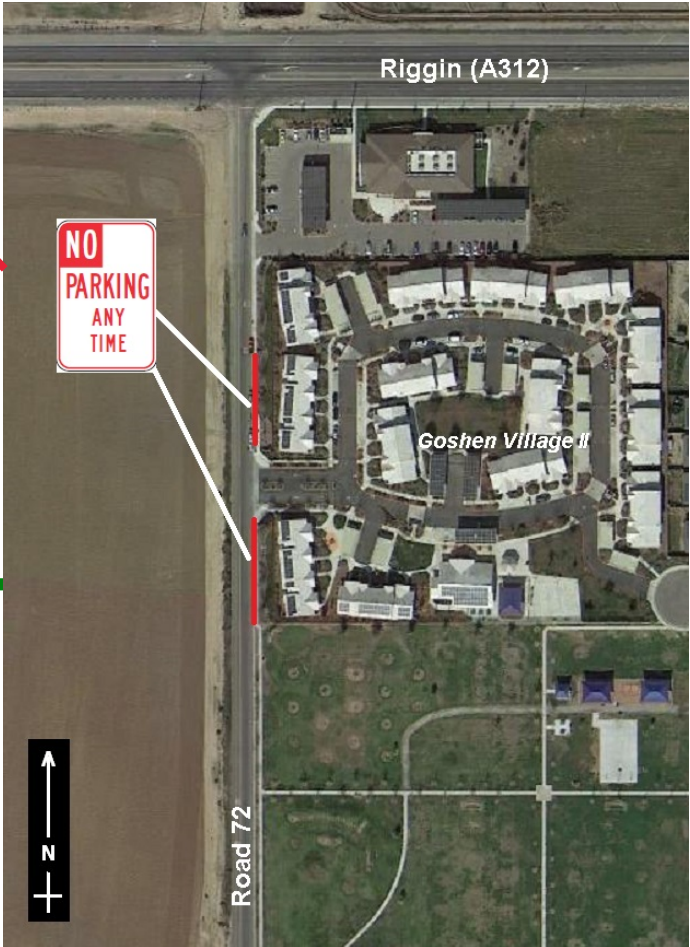
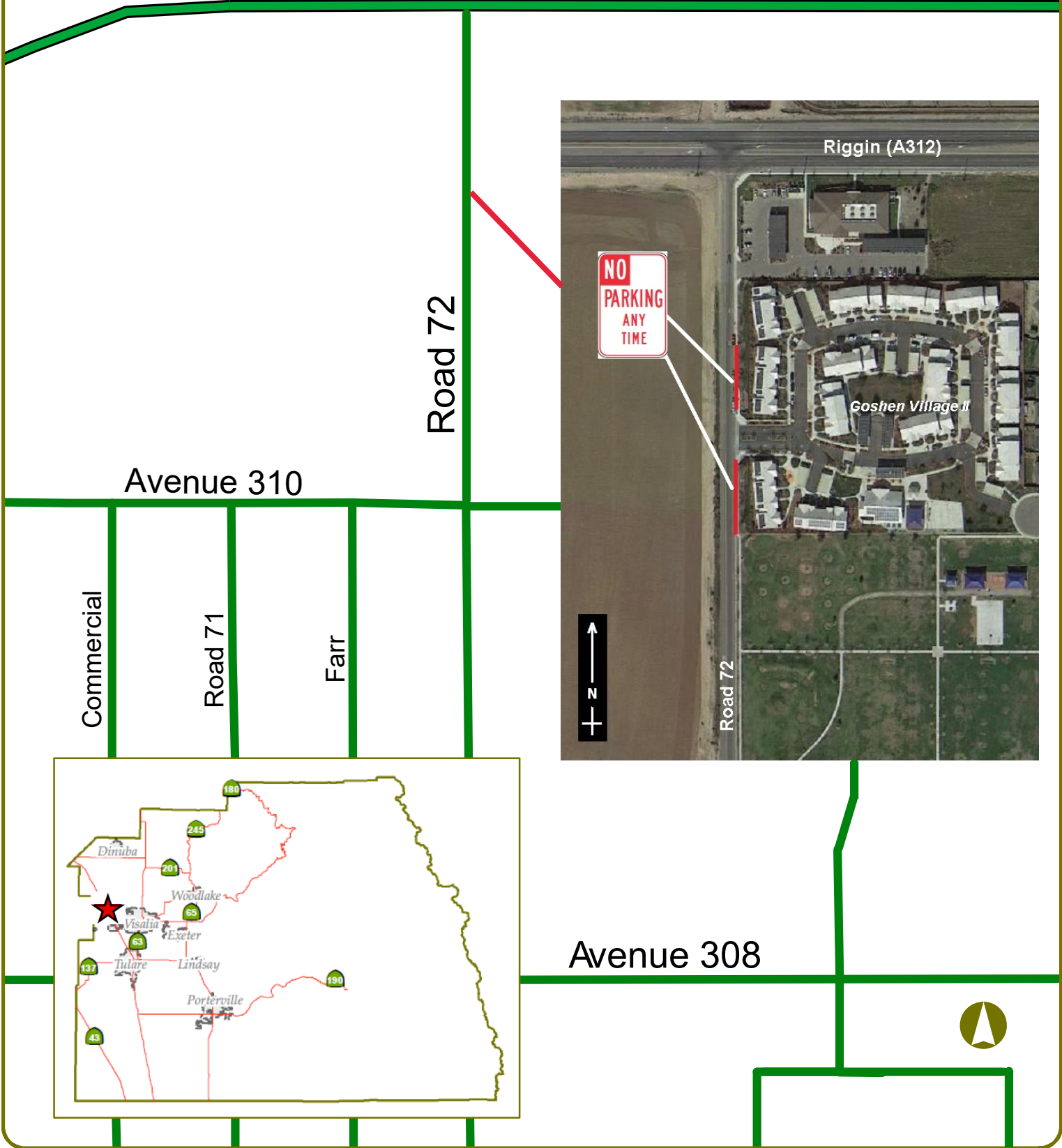

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Activity / Project: This project will enhance vehicular circulation and safety by creating "No Parking" restrictions on the east side of Road 72 south of Riggin Avenue in Goshen. The work will consist of installing "No Parking" signs and painting the curb red 100 feet north and 140 feet south of the Goshen Village II apartment complex entrance in the unincorporated community of Goshen, CA.

In response to safety concerns of parked vehicles creating a visibility obstruction, the Tulare County Resource Management Agency (RMA) conducted an investigation and determined that a "No Parking" restriction would improve sight visibility for traffic entering onto Road 72.
