**SUBJECT:** No Parking Restrictions on Road 168, South of Avenue 168 in the Community of Woodville

**REQUEST(S):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the designation of a "No Parking" restriction on Road 168 just south of Avenue 168 in the community of Woodville; and
2. Authorize the installation of "No Parking" signs, and establish a "No Parking" zone in Woodville, on the east side of Road 168 south of Avenue 168, by painting red approximately 17 feet of curb north and south of the driveway opposite Oak Avenue (LA167).
3. Approve a Categorical Exemption consistent with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Title 14 California Code of Regulations (CCR), Section 15061(b)(3) Common Sense Exemption;
4. Find there is no substantial evidence that proposed activity will have a significant effect on the environment and determine the Categorical Exemption is consistent with the CEQA Title 14 CCR, Section 15061(b)(3) Common Sense Exemption, that was prepared for the project reflects the independent judgment of the County and completed in compliance with the CEQA of 1970; and
5. Direct the Environmental Assessment Officer of the Tulare County Resource Management Agency, or designee, to file a Notice of Exemption with the Tulare County Clerk.

**SUMMARY:**

Road 168, south of Avenue 168 is located in the community of Woodville within Tulare County. Road 168 runs in a north and south direction.

**SUBJECT:** No Parking Restrictions on Road 168, South of Avenue 168 in the Community of Woodville

**DATE:** August 4, 2020

Recent improvements to Road 168 included the installation of curb, gutter and sidewalks. After the completion of the work, it was observed that a short section of roadway will not provide adequate roadway width to accommodate curbside parking. As a result, Tulare County Resource Management Agency (RMA) determined that a "No Parking" restriction installed north and south of the driveway opposite Oak Avenue on the east side of Road 168 in Woodville would eliminate a potential traffic hazard. Therefore, staff recommends the installation of "No Parking" signs and establish "No Parking" zones as stated in the request above.

Once this request is approved, this location will be added to the master list for parking restrictions maintained by the Tulare County RMA.

The Environmental Assessment Officer of the Tulare County RMA has found there is no substantial evidence that the activity/project will have a significant effect on the environment and determined a Categorical Exemption is consistent with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Title 14 CCR Section 15061(b)(3), the Common Sense Exemption is appropriate. A Notice of Exemption was prepared in compliance with the California State Guidelines for Implementation of CEQA. The Environmental Assessment Officer, or designee, will file the Notice of Exemption with the Tulare County Clerk upon approval by the Board.

**FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**


No Net County Cost to the General Fund.

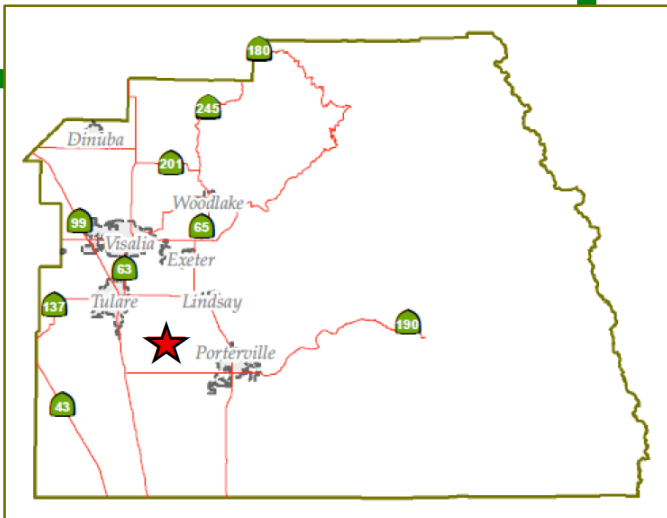
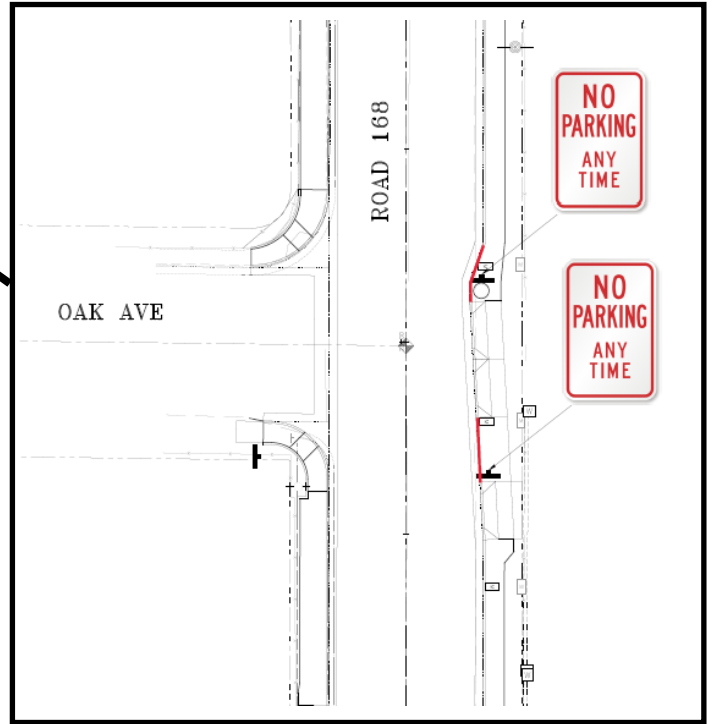

**Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Activity / Project:** This project will enhance vehicular circulation and safety by creating "No Parking" restrictions on the east side of Road 168 south of Avenue 168 in Woodville. This project will consist of installing "No Parking" signs and painting the curb red as stated, in this unincorporated community of Woodville, CA.

In response to concerns regarding traffic safety with vehicles parked on a section of roadway too narrow to accommodate curbside parking, the Tulare County Resource Management Agency (RMA) investigated this concern and determined that a "No Parking" restriction at this location would improve vehicle circulation and safety by providing a safer passage for vehicles.
