SUBJECT:

Approval of Program Year 2020-2021 WIOA Subgrant Agreement with the Incorporation of WIOA Youth Formula Funding.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve a subgrant agreement (AA111042) in the amount of \$4,571,373 with the State of California Employment Development Department (EDD) for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Youth programs, retroactive to 4/1/20 through 6/30/22. Retroactive approval is necessary because the State of California was not able to execute an agreement earlier due to the delay in the WIOA funding;
- 2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed agreement as of April 1, 2020 and that it was in the county's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date;
- 3. Authorize the Chairman to sign three (3) originals of the agreement.

SUMMARY:

This annual subgrant agreement with the State of California enables the Workforce Investment Board (WIB) of Tulare County to operate youth programs focused on employment and training benefiting the residents and business in Tulare County. EDD Subgrant agreement AA111042 allows spending from 4/1/20-6/30/22. Historically, funds are spent in the first program year (ending 6/30/21). However, if the funds are not entirely obligated or expended by 6/30/21, they will "roll over" and be available for expenditure through 6/30/22. Subsequent modifications of the agreement will provide additional funding to operate WIOA Adult and Dislocated Workers programs in Tulare County.

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the Incorporation of WIOA Youth Formula Funding.

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This agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

This program is financed through the EDD at no cost to Tulare County. These funds are contained in the Workforce Investment Board FY 2020-2021 budget request.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Economic Well-Being Initiative to promote economic development opportunities. The approval of this subgrant agreement helps fulfill this initiative by developing and sustaining a well-qualified labor pool and supporting vocational training opportunities.

Approval of the subgrant agreement also supports the Quality of Life Initiative of the strategic plan by promoting youth-oriented activities in small communities.
