**SUBJECT**: Increase BSA 045-1330 *Imprest Cash* to \$5,500 for use at Tulare

County Landfill System

#### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorize an increase of BSA 045-1330 *Imprest Cash* to \$5,500 to better service Cash clients of the Tulare County Landfill System.

#### **SUMMARY:**

On May 13, 2014, your Board authorized an increase to Balance Sheet Account (BSA) 045-1330 *Imprest Cash* on Board Resolution 2014-0311. This Resolution brought BSA 045-1330 to a new total of \$2,700. Due to the current status of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Department has experienced a 42% increase in transactions from cash clients at the Visalia Landfill and Teapot Dome Landfill. As a result, staff is making daily trips to banks and retail establishments to replenish their change drawers. The Department requests your Board authorize an increase of BSA 045-1330 to \$5,500 to better service the increased flow of cash customers at our landfills without needing to continuously replenish change drawers and improve our operational efficiency at both landfill locations.

#### FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is Zero Net County Cost to the General Fund related to this action. The funds in BSA 045-1330 are restricted to making change. The change drawers will be balanced and made whole at the end of each business day.
