SUBJECT:

Approve an Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture regarding European Grapevine Moth Trapping.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for providing State subvention in the amount of \$106,072.00 to offset costs of providing European Grapevine Moth detection trapping services, retroactive to January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020. The Agreement is retroactive because the document was not received from the State until June 8, 2020.
- 2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed Agreement as of January 1, 2020, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the Agreement on that date.
- 3. Authorize the Chairman to sign two copies of the Agreement.

SUMMARY:

This agreement is intended to render State financial aid to the County for providing European Grapevine Moth detection trapping. The early detection of this detrimental pest is critically important to the agricultural industry in our county and will allow for the early detection and delimitation of an exotic insect pest that threatens our agricultural industry and our ability to export products from our county.

This agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel. Deviations from the standard County contract include:

• Mutual Liability - Neither party to the agreement will indemnify the other.

The County signs the agreement first.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

No additional net County cost to the General Fund. This Agreement provides \$106,072 to the County to provide detection trapping for European Grapevine Moth. The costs and revenues are recurring for this program. The revenue and associated expenditures for this detection program have been included in the Agricultural Commissioner's Fiscal Year 2020/2021 budget.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Economic Well-Being Initiative to promote economic development opportunities, effective growth management and a quality standard of living. The request to approve this Agreement will provide a funding source that will allow the continuation of a program that protects the County's agricultural economy.
