SUBJECT: Approve a Capital Asset Purchase

REQUEST(S):
That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the capital asset purchase of Cisco Duo Secure Multi Factor Authentication Licensing in an amount not to exceed \$350,000;
2. Approve the necessary budget adjustments per the attached AUD 308 (4/5ths vote required).

SUMMARY:

Cisco Duo Security Access is a multi-factor authentication platform that adds policy and control over which users, devices, and networks are permitted to access County applications.

With the surge of remote workers, due to the COVID19 Pandemic, DUO Security will provide improved remote access security for the remote access work force in a user friendly and accessible method. Primarily DUO will secure any remote worker connections by requiring a second factor of identification on systems like virtual private networks, virtual desktop infrastructure, and various cloud applications. In addition, it will also increase the County's ability to manage those identities and connections with policies to increase security in a telecommuting environment.

Your board previously approved the County of Tulare CARES Act Funding Plan on July 14, 2020, Resolution No. 2020-0424, to expand and improve the capability of

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the County's technology infrastructure, networks, platforms and employee devices to telework and enhance the ability to provide quality service to residents. This capital asset purchase will assist in meeting that need.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The cost of this capital asset is an amount not to exceed \$350,000, to be paid from account number 035-090-9919-8353. This capital asset purchase will utilize the CARES Act funding to expand and improve the capability of the County's technology infrastructure, networks, platforms and employee devices to telework and enhance the ability to provide quality service to residents. There is no Net County Cost.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Organizational Performance Initiative to which this purchase applies. The continued maintenance and enhancements for the County of Tulare property systems provides stability of operations to support better service delivery.
