TOTAL BOOKINGS FOR 2019

- The Tulare County Sheriff's Office had approximately 21,062 Bookings in 2019
- The Sheriff's Office received 424 detainer requests from immigration officials representing 0.020% of total bookings
- Custodial release information for 51 individuals was provided to immigration officials
 - ** Representing 0.002% of total bookings**



- The Sheriff's Office received 424 detainer requests from ICE
- Subsequently, ICE took custody of 51 inmates upon release
- The Sheriff's Office did not provide ICE access to 373 inmates



THE 373 INMATES NOT RELEASED TO ICE:

- 109 requests did not meet the legal requirements of the VALUES/TRUTH Acts and the Sheriff's Office did not allow ICE access to the inmates
- 264 requests from ICE satisfied the legal requirements of the VALUES/TRUTH Acts, but ICE did not take custody of the inmates
 - ✓231 of these inmates were released back to the public consistent with operating procedures and the VALUES/TRUTH Acts
 - √33 inmates were still in custody pending trial or serving their sentences at the end of 2019
 - The 33 inmates were in custody on charges ranging from murder, serious sex offenses and other serious crimes
