SUBJECT: Approve an agreement with Central Valley Recovery Services, Inc.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an agreement with Central Valley Recovery Services, Inc. for the provision of substance abuse residential, outpatient, intensive outpatient, and transitional services in an amount not to exceed \$1,777,375 retroactive to July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021. This agreement is retroactive due to extended negotiations of the agreement. It was impracticable for the Board to take action prior to July 1, 2020 due to the time needed to process, prepare, and submit the agenda item.
2. Find that the Board had the authority to enter into the agreement as of July 1, 2020 and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date.
3. Authorize the Chair of the Board to sign one (1) copy of the agreement.

SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Health & Human Services Agency, (HHS) Mental Health Branch collaborates with Central Valley Recovery Services, Inc. (CVRS) a community-based, non-profit organization to provide residential and community alcohol and drug recovery services. This program is operated under the California State Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) Substance Use Disorder (SUD) program regulations, as outlined in Title 9 of the Administrative Code. CVRS provides adult SUD services in residential, outpatient treatment group and individual counseling, intensive outpatient treatment group and individual counseling, detoxification, and transitional

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services. It is estimated that approximately 462 residential and 350 outpatient consumers will benefit from this agreement for Fiscal Year 2020-2021.

This agreement did not include a Request for Proposal process because CVRS has been a long-standing provider of alcohol and substance abuse disorder treatment services in Tulare County.

This agreement does not deviate from the standard County boilerplate.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The budgeted costs associated with this agreement will be included in the HSA budget, lines 6041-7052 for \$250,000, 6068-7052 for \$909,909 and 6069-7052 for \$617,466, 7052 medical providers, for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 in an amount not to exceed \$1,777,375. The average cost per residential consumer is \$2,189. The average cost per outpatient consumer is \$1,973. The estimated amount is subject to change based on actual utilization. This funding is derived from Social Services single allocation and the Mental Health Branch is reimbursed through an interdepartmental transfer, Drug Medi-Cal, 2011 Realignment, and through the Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant. There is no additional net cost to the County General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Quality of Life Initiative that encourages innovative provision of quality supportive services for at-risk adults, youth and children in state and federally mandated programs. This agreement increases the ability to fulfill that obligation through SUD residential, outpatient, intensive outpatient, and transitional programs.
