SUBJECT:

Approve a Capital Asset Purchase

#### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve the capital asset purchase of a Radio Frequency Identification Gateway System in an amount not to exceed \$215,000.
- 2. Approve the necessary budget adjustments per the attached AUD 308 (4/5ths vote required).

#### SUMMARY:

The purchase of Library radio-frequency identification (RFID) gateway system provides the County with the ability to serve its residents and employees by reducing interpersonal contact to meet COVID 19 pandemic response guidelines.

This technology helps Library staff to process items quickly, avoid unnecessary delays, and minimize the need for physical proximity between staff and patrons. RFID tags added to each library item, allows a stack of materials to be checked out by RFID tags as opposed to scanning individual barcodes, leading to a much faster borrowing experience with little to no touching and improved materials security. RFID also allows for simple and quick automated check in/return processes.

COVID 19 created a challenge to provide in-person services to the Library's over 53,000 patrons, as our circulation and other services are considered high touch and retouch actions. Implementing RFID allows the Library to provide touchless check out, including patron self-checkout and staff assisted, of over 400,000 physical

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items each year. RFID not only helps deter the spread of COVID 19, but any future viruses and/or flus.

For more than 20 years libraries in Asia, Europe, and North America have used RFID successfully. In California, for example, RFID tagged collections and technology are found in Fresno, San Diego, San Francisco, Alameda, and other library systems. The County Librarian has experience with three RFID installations in California, in Santa Clara, Lincoln, and Long Beach, including leading the implementation of the first RFID project in California.

The Board previously approved the Tulare County CARES Act Funding Plan on July 14, 2020, Resolution No. 2020-0424, to improve the capability of the County's technology to provide quality services with minimal to no contact with constituents. This purchase will assist the County Library system meet its goal to reduce person to person contact during the COVID 19 pandemic.

It should be noted that the County Librarian has chosen to utilize Solano County Library RFP 525-602-17, awarded with Bibliotheca, LLC, to expedite the procurement process and to ensure the lowest available cost.

#### FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The cost of the capital assets in an amount not to exceed \$215,000 to be paid from account number 035-090-9919-8306. There is no Net County Cost to the General Fund.

#### LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan addresses Quality of Life Initiative and Organizational Performance. The purchase fulfills the initiative by providing touchless, streamlined, and patron-initiated services at all seventeen branches, many in rural and underserved areas of the community. In addition, the continued maintenance and enhancements for the County of Tulare technology structure provides stability of operations to support improved service delivery.
