SUBJECT: Approve an Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for providing State subvention in the amount of \$1,080 to offset costs of providing soil treatment supervision, commodity treatment supervision and commodity and/ or soil sampling as required by the Nematode Control Program, effective July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015. This Agreement is retroactive because the document was not received from the State until July 3, 2014.

2. Find that the Board had the authority to enter into the proposed Agreement as of July 1, 2014, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the Agreement on that date.

3. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the Agreement.

SUMMARY:

This agreement is intended to render State financial aid to the County for providing Nematode Control Program services and enforcement of nematode regulations. These services will protect the county's nursery industry by insuring that plant shipments are free of nematodes of concern, thus allowing them to continue shipping nursery plants out of Tulare county.

A prior Agreement, identical except for the time period and dollar value, was approved as to form by the County Counsel and was approved by the Board of

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Supervisors on June 25, 2013. The deviations from the County Contract Protocol included in the original agenda item were:

- a. Indemnification: Contractor indemnifies State only.
- b. Disputes: If there is a dispute, the decision is of the Agency Secretary or Designee shall be final.
- c. Potential Subcontractors: County must get CDFA approval before hiring contractors and must use an existing written policy or competitive bidding. County will be responsible to the State for acts/omissions of County's subcontractors.
- d. Right to Terminate: State may terminate without cause with 30 days written notice or immediately with cause. The County may submit a written request to terminate only if the State substantially fails to perform its responsibilities. CDFA can terminate if no funding is available.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

This Agreement provides \$1,080 to the County of providing soil treatment supervision, commodity treatment supervision and commodity and/ or soil sampling as required by the Nematode Control Program. No additional net County cost to the General Fund. Revenues and the associated expenditures for this program have been included in the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer's Budget for fiscal year 2014/2015.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Economic Well-Being Initiative to promote economic development opportunities, effective growth management and a quality standard of living. The request to approve this Agreement will provide a continued funding source that will allow the continuation of a program that protects the County's agricultural economy.
