## RECOGNIZING SEPTEMBER 17-23, 2014 AS CONSTITUTION WEEK IN TULARE COUNTY

WHEREAS, on September 17, 1787, the United States Constitution was signed by 55 delegates to the Constitutional Convention in Philadelphia's Independence Hall; and

WHEREAS, September 17, 2014 marks the two hundred and twenty-seventh anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to officially recognize this magnificent document and the anniversary of its creation; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to officially recognize the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion; and


WHEREAS, Constitution Week was officially enacted on August 2, 1956 by President Dwight D. Eisenhower from a congressional resolution petitioned by the Daughters of the American Revolution; and


WHEREAS, public law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through 23 as constitution week.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tulare County Board of Supervisors do hereby recognize September 17-23, 2014 as Constitution Week in Tulare County.


