SUBJECT: Approval of a Grant Award Agreement with the Board of State and Community Corrections

- REQUEST(S):**
That the Board of Supervisors:
1. Approve the Grant Award Agreement with the Board of State and Community Corrections for the Juvenile Accountability Block Grants (JABG) Program in the amount of \$22,520, with a \$2,502 match, for the period of July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015. The proposed agreement is retroactive due to the date it was received from the Board of State and Community Corrections.
 2. Find that the Board had the authority to enter into the proposed agreement as of July 1, 2014, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date.
 3. Authorize the Chairman to sign five copies of the Agreement.

SUMMARY:
Since 1998, the Juvenile Accountability Block Grants (JABG) Program has been made possible through a yearly federal appropriation. The State of California grants these funds to units of local government based on a formula calculation.

The Probation Department will utilize JABG 2014/2015 funds to support a portion of a full-time Probation Officer III salary for the purpose of providing community-based probation supervision services to maximum-risk juvenile probations, thereby enhancing the scope of influence in the accountability of juvenile offenders.

The Board approved the submission of an application on May 20, 2014 for continued grant funding, available through the Juvenile Accountability Block Grants

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(JABG) Programs and administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections, in the amount of \$22,520, with a \$2,502 match, for the period of July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015.

A prior agreement, identical except for the term and dollar value, was approved as to form by County Counsel on October 9, 2012. The deviations from County contract protocol in that agreement included the following: 1) County must indemnify State; 2) State may terminate agreement for cause with 30 days written notice, but no termination authority afforded to the County; 3) County must sign the agreement first. The proposed renewal agreement does not include any additional deviations from County contract protocol.


FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The total project cost for Fiscal Year 2014/2015 is \$25,022 and is included in the FY 2014/2015 proposed budget. The grant allocation is \$22,250. The required cash match of \$2,502 will be made by the Probation Department. The salary and benefit cost for on FTE Probation Officer III is \$79,474. The remaining costs associated with the position are offset by SB 670 revenue.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic business plan includes the Safety and Security initiative that provides for the safety and security of the public. The approval of this agreement helps fulfill this initiative by providing funds to offset the costs of one Probation Office III to continue to provide community-based probation supervision services to maximum-risk juvenile probationers and enhance the scope of influence in the accountability of juvenile offenders.
