**SUBJECT:** Dedicate the newly constructed Avenue 416 bridge as the R.B. Oliver Bridge

**REQUEST(S):**  
That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the dedication of the recently constructed Avenue 416 bridge as the R.B. Oliver Bridge
2. Adopt a proclamation acknowledging this Board action.

**SUMMARY:**

In December of 2009, the County of Tulare was authorized for approximately \$2.1 million to fund the engineering for the replacement of the Avenue 416 Kings River Bridge. This Avenue 416 Kings River Bridge was originally constructed in 1959. The replacement bridge was completed earlier this year, and consists of a new, state of the art, four lane structure. The total project cost was approximately \$21.5 million, which consisted of approximately \$19 million in federal funding (Highway Bridge Program), \$0.5 million in state funding (Proposition 1B) and \$2 million in local funding (Measure R).

The original bridge was dedicated to R.B. Oliver who served with great honor and distinction as a member of the Tulare County Board of Supervisors for five consecutive terms between 1931 and 1951. While a member of the Board of Supervisors, R.B Oliver was particularly instrumental in the construction of the County bridge on Avenue 416 (El Monte Way) which crosses the Kings River west of the city of Dinuba. The Board of Supervisors designated that bridge, located just
