SUBJECT: Cooperative Agreement with Porterville Unified School District

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the Cooperative Agreement with the Porterville Unified School District for the John J. Doyle Elementary School Safe Routes to School Project; and
2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to sign the Cooperative Agreement on behalf of the County of Tulare after review and approval as to form by County Counsel.

SUMMARY:

The John J. Doyle Elementary School Safe Route to School Project will construct approximately 650 lineal feet of 5-foot wide asphalt sidewalk along the south side of Orange Avenue between the school and Maurer Avenue, a cross walk across Date and Success to the south of the school that will include flashing beacons and driver feedback signs to improve safety, and approximately 600 lineal feet of 8-foot wide asphalt sidewalk from said crosswalk to the southern entrance to the school. The majority of the 8-foot wide sidewalk will be constructed on school property, and the School District will assume maintenance responsibilities for this portion of the work after construction is complete. The purpose of the project is to provide school children a safe walking path to get to and from school.

This Cooperative Agreement defines the responsibilities between the District and the County of Tulare for performance of the work. Specifically, this agreement defines that the County will act as the lead agency and be responsible for the project from design through construction. The District will assume maintenance and

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upkeep responsibilities for the asphalt sidewalk on District property.

Construction is anticipated to begin in January 2015.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is no net cost to the County General Fund.

The total project cost is estimated to be \$325,000, which consists of \$42,000 in preliminary engineering costs, \$230,000 in construction costs, \$23,000 in contingencies and \$30,000 in construction engineering costs.

The project will be funded according to the following breakdown:
