**SUBJECT:** Program Supplement Agreement N079 with the State of California

**REQUEST(S):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve Program Supplement No. N079 in the amount of \$820,673 with the California Department of Transportation for environmental mitigation for the Avenue 416 Kings River Bridge Project; and
2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board Supervisors to sign Program Supplement No. N079 on behalf of Tulare County.

**SUMMARY:**

On June 20, 2014, Tulare County received federal authorization to proceed (E-76) with the construction phase of this project, which includes on-site and off-site re-vegetation restoration as mitigation for permanent impacts (i.e. removal) to trees and shrubs resulting from the Avenue 416 Kings River Bridge construction project.

With the bridge construction project now complete, the on-site re-vegetation restoration project is scheduled to commence in December of 2014, and will consist of the planting and establishment of native trees and shrubs to compensate for those removed during construction of the bridge project. The on-site re-vegetation restoration project will require an establishment period of approximately 5 years. Due to the number of plantings required, and the limited availability of on-site space, off-site mitigation is also required for this project. The off-site mitigation has been identified to be established at an approximate 3 acre conservation area located in the Kaweah Oaks Preserve in Tulare County. The County will enter into an agreement with Sequoia Riverlands Trust, the non-profit organization that manages
