DATE: For Board of Supervisor's regular meeting of May 9, 2006.

SUBJECT: Agreement between Tulare County and California Dept. of Food and Agriculture for petroleum product and weighmaster inspection during fiscal year 2006/2007.

REQUEST: Approve and authorize the Chairman to sign Agreement No. 06-0055 between the County of Tulare and the California Department of Food and Agriculture, providing State subvention funds to offset costs of petroleum product compliance and weighmaster enforcement programs, effective July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007.

SUMMARY/JUSTIFICATION: This contract is intended to provide financial aid to the County for inspections, and sampling, relating to the advertising and labeling of petroleum and automotive products at establishments selling or distributing petroleum and/or automotive products; and weighmaster audit and verification inspections. The agreement will provide funding during FY 2006/2007.

FINANCING: The County will receive \$15,675 for fiscal year 2006/2007. State revenues and the associated expenditures for this program have been included in the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer's proposed budget for FY 2006/2007. There will be a net county cost of approximately \$960 (6%) for conducting these two programs. The effective date of the agreement is July 1, 2006.

ALTERNATIVES: No action or disapproval would mean that the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer would not be able to receive financial aid from the California Department of Food and Agriculture to offset costs incurred in inspection of petroleum and automotive products during FY 2006/2007.

INVOLVEMENT OF OTHER DEPARTMENTS/AGENCIES: The California Department of Food and Agriculture. County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to form.
